2026-2027 Course Descriptions

LEVEL A (1st – 3rd Grade) Student fee of \$45.00 covers all three class periods
(The American Sign Language class requires an additional \$5.00 fee for printing purposes)

The following classes cover two semesters. Each student is required to bring their own school supplies, (i.e. scissors, pens, pencils, colored pencils, notebook paper, glue sticks, etc.). A detailed supply list will be provided in each class syllabus from the teacher. Please note that all class fees are per student and per year.

* Level A has two class groups for Rocket Science Jr. and Music with the Masters. Group 1 is designed for younger students, (1st graders and young second graders). Group 2 is designed for the older students, (older 2nd graders and third graders).

1st period Group 1, 3rd period Group 2

Music with the Masters – In this engaging, hands-on class, students will explore the lives and music of famous composers like Beethoven, Mozart, and Bach. Through fun activities and creative projects, students will become familiar with many musical instruments. Students will also learn to play the recorder, practicing basic notes, rhythms, and simple songs. As they grow in skill and confidence, they will connect what they play to the music they are learning about.

1st period Group 2, 3rd period Group 1

Rocket Science Jr. – This class will be exploring aspects of engineering as it applies to space - getting to space, living in space, working in space, and coming back down to earth. We will explore physical & chemical aspects to the challenges of space travel & living as well as utilizing engineering to try to solve issues that come up when space is involved. Some of the projects of the year will include creating a diorama of a space station on Mars, building rockets, and figuring out how to eat in space.

2nd period (Group 1 and 2 students choose one of these two class options)

Lego Challenge Jr. – Get ready to build, create, and imagine! In this LEGO class, students will tackle fun and sometimes tricky building challenges on their own and with friends. From wild creations to team projects, this class is all about creativity, teamwork, and thinking like a builder!

American Sign Language – Students will develop a basic understanding of Deaf Culture as well as signing skills through videos, songs, and games with a focus on fingerspelling. Our curriculum will include a combination of signing resources such as Duke the Deaf Dog ASL Series, Rocky Mountain Deaf School, and LifePrint. Students will have suggested take-home activities to help them practice and progress in the class. This class is for beginners and for students that have taken sign language previously.
